


TRASH ON THE HILL AUGUST 2023










Trash Remaining after haulers have picked up




Same problem alleys every year for the past 12+ years




#### What makes the Hill unique?


- Fall semester coincides with hyperphagia
- New set of students every year
- Wear and tear on the cans, mutlitple users
- Multiple containers on each alley
- Code Enforcement does not have adequate staffing
- Bear resistant cans is an unsustainable solution

Unfortunately the solution for a large part of Boulder is not working on the Hill. So we need a new approach.




Missing Piece -engaging land owners, landlords, rental management companies



Replace plastic bins with solid enclosures






